Bible Phrase: Love God. Deuteronomy 6:5

Scripture Reference: Numbers 13–14

Bible Story: Moses and the people were camped in the desert. Nearby was the special land God had said He would give them. Moses chose 12 men to go and look at the land.



Moses said, “Go and see what the land is like. See if the people there are strong. Are there big towns or small towns? Find out if the land is good. Does the land have trees on it? Bring back some of the fruit grown there.”

So the 12 men went to look at the land. In one place, they cut off a branch with some grapes on it. They also found some figs and other fruit. The men looked at the land for 40 days. Then they went back to Moses to tell him what they saw. Ten of the men said to Moses, “The land we saw is good. This is some of the fruit we found there. But the people who live there are stronger than we are. We are afraid to go there again.”

Two of the men, Joshua and Caleb, said, “The land we saw is good. God wants us to live in this special place. He will help us. We love God and want to do what He says.” Joshua and Caleb knew God would take care of them.


Parents:
