- If you are honest, do you find that you are holding on to "boxes" of your own kingdom that must be surrendered before you can truly say you want God's will more than you want your own? What would make you willing to surrender those boxes so you can truly say "Thy will be done"?

In your time with God this week:

1. **Thank God** for The Lord's Prayer and for all the ways it guides believers in their spiritual journey.
2. **Ask God** to show you the places/things you have been unwilling to surrender to His will in your life.
3. **Commit** to take the first step to surrender completely to God's will for you over your will for yourself.
