Scripture Reference: *Matthew 28:16-20;*
Acts 2:1-2,6-11,14,22,37-41

Bible Story: Jesus had told His special helpers to tell people everywhere that He was God's Son. Jesus said, "Tell them about Me—all the things you have seen and heard."

One day Peter and Jesus' other special helpers were in Jerusalem. Many people were in the city for a special celebration. So Peter decided to stand up and talk to the crowd about Jesus.

Peter said, "Listen, my friends. Let me tell you about Jesus. Jesus was sent by God." The people quietly listened as Peter continued talking about Jesus.

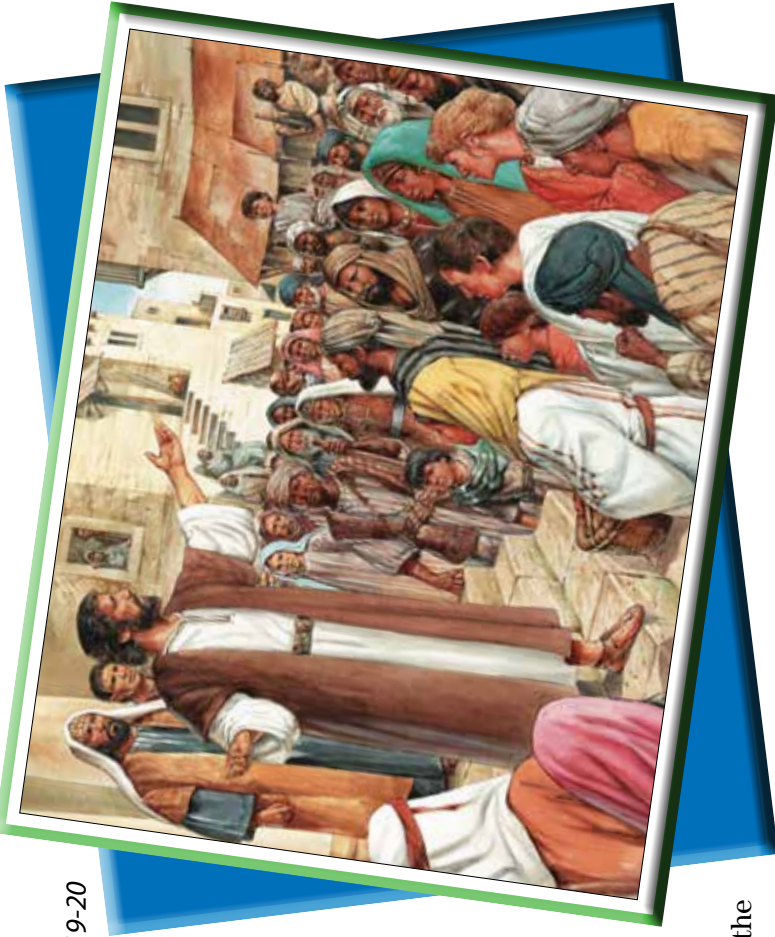
When the people heard what Peter said, they asked, "What should we do?"
