Bible Phrase: God made the sun, moon, and stars.
Genesis 1:16

Scripture Reference: *Genesis 1:1-8, 14-19*

Bible Story: A long time ago, before there was anything else in the world, there was God. There were no people, no trees, no food, no sun, and no animals. Darkness was everywhere. There was nothing except God.

God had a wonderful plan to make the world. The Bible tells us that God said, "Let there be light"; and suddenly there was light. God saw that the light was good. Now there was light and darkness. God called the light *day*, and He called the darkness *night*. God made daytime and nighttime.


God made the beautiful sky. Sometimes the sky is blue. Sometimes the sky is gray. Other times the sky may be pink or orange. God made the bright, warm sun to shine in the daytime. God made the moon to shine softly at night. God made many twinkling stars to shine with the moon in the nighttime sky.


