

God Made Land and Plants

Bible Phrase: God made plants to grow on the land.
Genesis 1:11

Scripture Reference: *Genesis 1:9-13*

Bible Story: God was making a beautiful world. God had made daytime and nighttime. Next God made the sky and water. Water was everywhere.

God said, “Let there be dry ground.” And that is exactly what happened. The water was put into lakes, rivers, and oceans. God called the dry ground *land*. There was hard, rocky land, and there was soft, sandy land. There were big mountains and flat land. God looked at the land and water He had made. God thought it was good.

Then God said, “Let all kinds of plants begin to grow on the land.” And that is what happened. There were tiny plants like grass and big plants like trees. Some plants grew delicious fruit like bananas, apples, strawberries, and watermelon. Other plants grew vegetables like green beans, corn, and potatoes. There were plants with flowers in many colors. God made the plants with seed so that more plants could grow.

God saw the trees and plants He had made. God thought it was all very good.

Parents:

- Take your preschooler for a walk. Say, “God made all the trees and flowers that grow.”
- Sing (tune “God Is So Good”): “God made the flowers; God made the flowers; God made the flowers; Thank You, God, for flowers.” Repeat; substitute things your preschooler suggests, such as “God made the trees . . .”

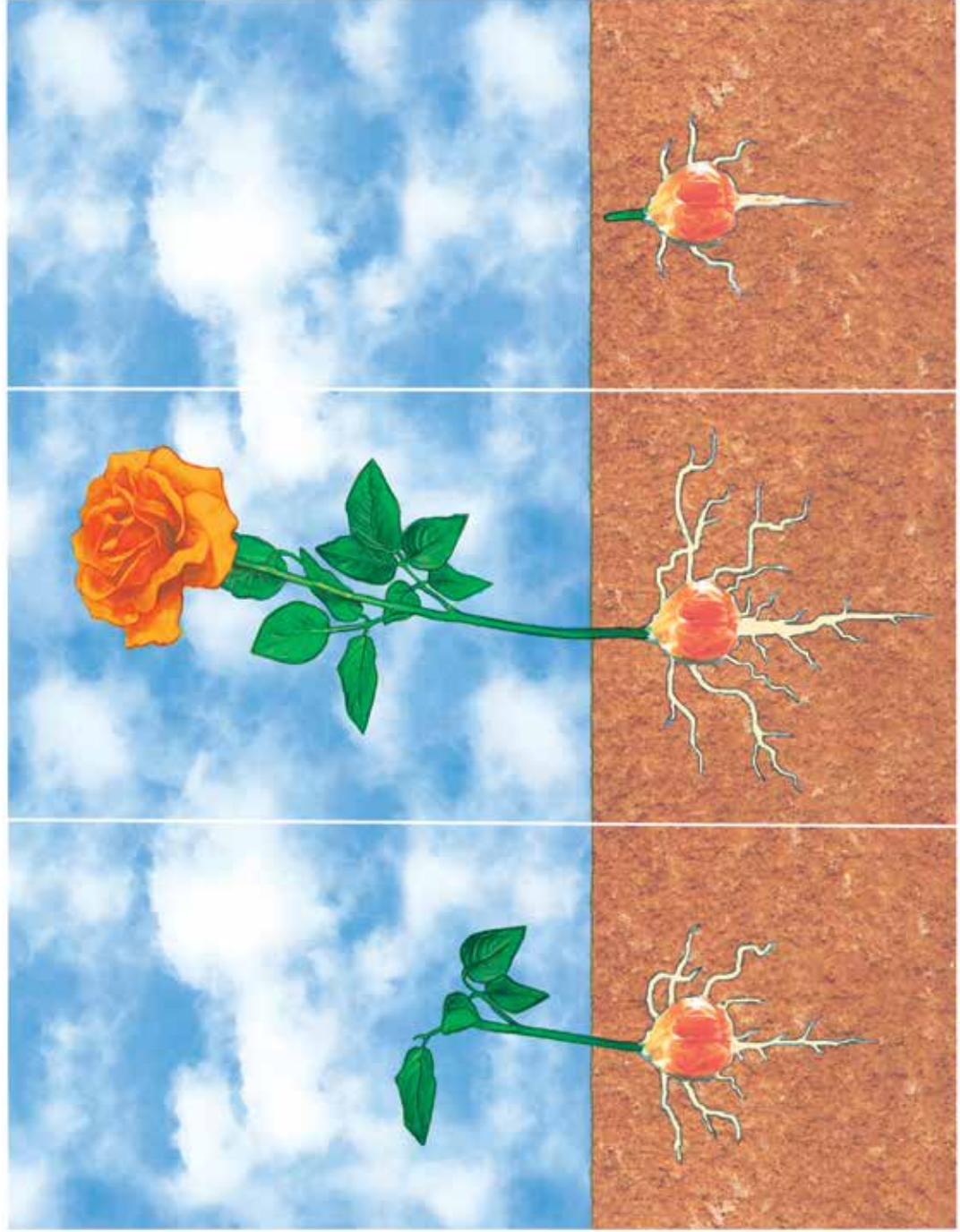


Fall Unit 1 Bible Verse: “This is the day that the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.” Psalm 118:24
