Bible Phrase: God made animals. *Genesis 1:25*

Scripture Reference: *Genesis 1:20-25,30*

Bible Story: God had made a beautiful world.

He made the sun to shine during the day. God made the moon and stars to shine at night. He made the water and dry land. God made plants of all kinds to grow on the land. Then God made animals to live in the water. He made all kinds of fish. God made turtles, whales, frogs, and starfish. God made everything that lives in the water.

Next God made animals called birds to fly in the sky. He made little birds and big birds. God made different kinds of birds. He made cardinals, robins, eagles, and hummingbirds. God thought it was all very good.

Then God made animals that walk on the land. He made all kinds of animals. God made lions, monkeys, giraffes, and zebras. He made horses, cows, dogs, and cats. God knew that the water and plants He had already made would be food for all of the animals.

God looked at the fish, birds, and animals He had made. God thought it was all very good.

Parents:

- Talk to your child about how God made all the animals. Take turns naming a different animal and making the animal's sound.
- Say the Bible phrase "God made animals." Ask your child to say it with you. During the week, substitute into the verse animals you see such as "God made kittens."
