Additional Information:

- Enrollment is for the entire school year, unless you notify us in writing of withdrawal by Dec. 1, otherwise you will be responsible for tuition and costume fee.
- 3 year olds must be potty trained to participate.
- Students should be of age or grade by September 1, 2020.
- Ballet III is 2 days per week required unless you have permission from the Director. Open to students 6th grade and up.
- Classes need a minimum of 6 students to make.
- Ballet families interested in utilizing the workout equipment, gym or walking track are eligible to purchase a discounted Monthly Family Facilities membership for \$15/month.

Dress Code:

3-5 yr olds- pink leotard*, pink footed tights, and pink ballet shoes (K5 and 1st grade combined classes will wear blue leotards)
1st/2nd grades- light blue leotard*, pink footed tights, and pink ballet shoes
3rd grade and above- black leotard*, pink footed tights, and pink ballet shoes (2nd/3rd grade combined classes will wear black leotards)

**leotards should have no decorations or attached skirts; any sleeve length is fine, but no camisoles, please.*

Safe Dancing

The health and safety of our dancers and instructors is a top priority.

- We are implementing reduced class sizes.
- Hand sanitizer upon entry
- Barres cleaned between classes and students will have a designated barre space.
- High touch surfaces and floors regularly cleaned.
- Distancing between students in class, including clearly marked spots on the floor.
- All parties are required to wear a mask while coming and going and if waiting on campus during class time. We will update this policy as needed.
- There will be spread out waiting areas for parents that choose to remain during class time.
- Families should self-screen before coming to the church campus for any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit, and known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19.
