Bible Phrase: A friend loves at all times. *Proverbs 17:17*

Scripture Reference: *Luke 10:38-42*

Bible Story: Jesus and His helpers were traveling. They came to the town where two sisters lived. The sisters were named Mary and Martha.

Jesus and His helpers walked to Mary and Martha's house. The sisters were so happy to see Jesus.

Mary sat on the floor near Jesus. She listened carefully as Jesus talked. Mary wanted to hear everything Jesus said. While Mary was listening, Martha was getting a meal ready for Jesus.
