

Jesus Read the Bible

Bible Phrase: Jesus read the Bible at church. *Luke 4:16*

Scripture Reference: *Luke 4:16-22*

Bible Story: Jesus went many places telling people about God. One day Jesus went to Nazareth. Nazareth was the town where Jesus' family lived when He was a boy.

While Jesus was there, He went to the synagogue (church). He stood where everyone could see Him. A church helper handed Jesus the Bible scroll.

Jesus carefully unrolled the Bible scroll and began to read. Jesus read, "God sent Me to teach people about Him. God sent Me to help people."

Then Jesus rolled up the Bible scroll. He gave it to the church helper and sat down.

Everyone was watching Jesus. Jesus looked at the people and said, "These words in the Bible are about Me."

The people were surprised at what Jesus said.

- Use the Bible with your preschooler at dinner or before bed. Talk about how we can use the Bible, just as Jesus did.
- Encourage your preschooler to hold the Bible and turn the pages. Help your older preschooler find the word *Jesus* in Luke 4.
