Bible Phrase: Jesus chose helpers. *Mark 3:14*

Scripture Reference: *Matthew 4:18-22; 10:2-4*

Bible Story: One day Jesus was walking beside a large lake, the Sea of Galilee. He saw two brothers, Simon Peter and Andrew. These brothers were fishermen. They were busy throwing a net into the lake, trying to catch fish.

Jesus kept walking. Jesus saw two other brothers, James and John. They were fishermen, too. James and John worked catching fish with their father.

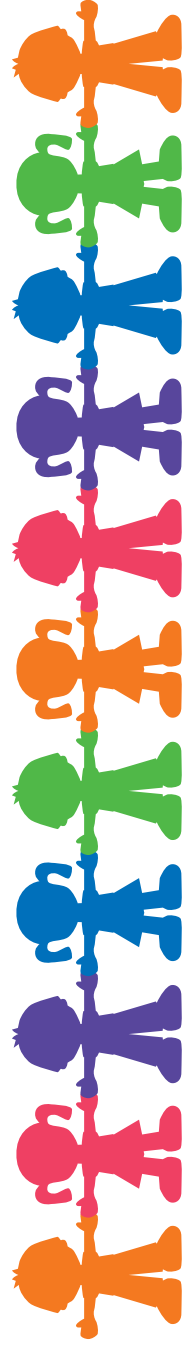
“Come. Follow Me,” Jesus said to the brothers.

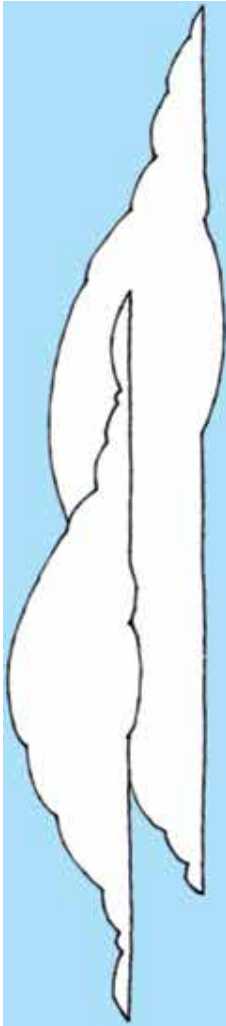

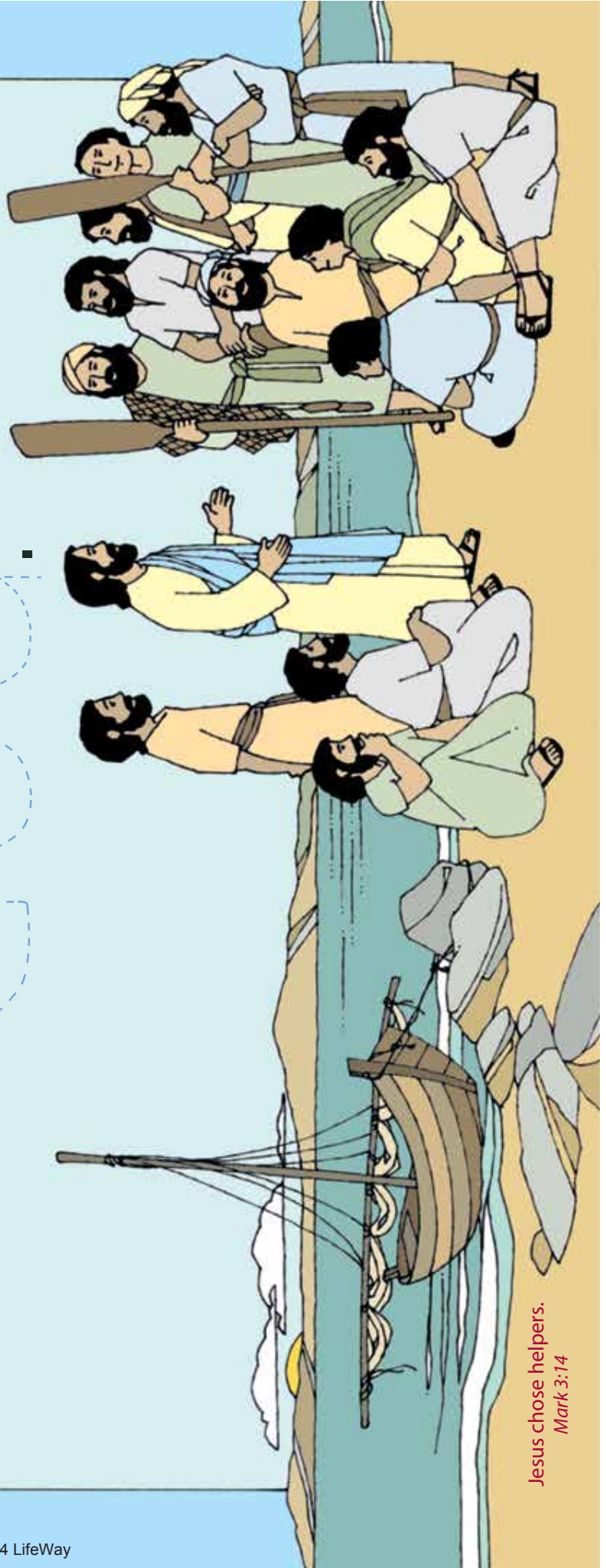
