

David Listened to His Father

Bible Phrase: Listen to your father and mother.
Proverbs 1:8

Scripture Reference: *1 Samuel 16:11-12; 17:12-22*

Bible Story: David had a big family. He was the youngest brother. David had seven older brothers!

Everyone in David's family had special jobs to do. David's job was to take care of his father's sheep. David's three oldest brothers were in the king's army.

One day David's father said, "Take loaves of bread and some cooked grain to your brothers at the army camp. Take 10 cheeses to the army commander, too. Find out how your brothers are doing."

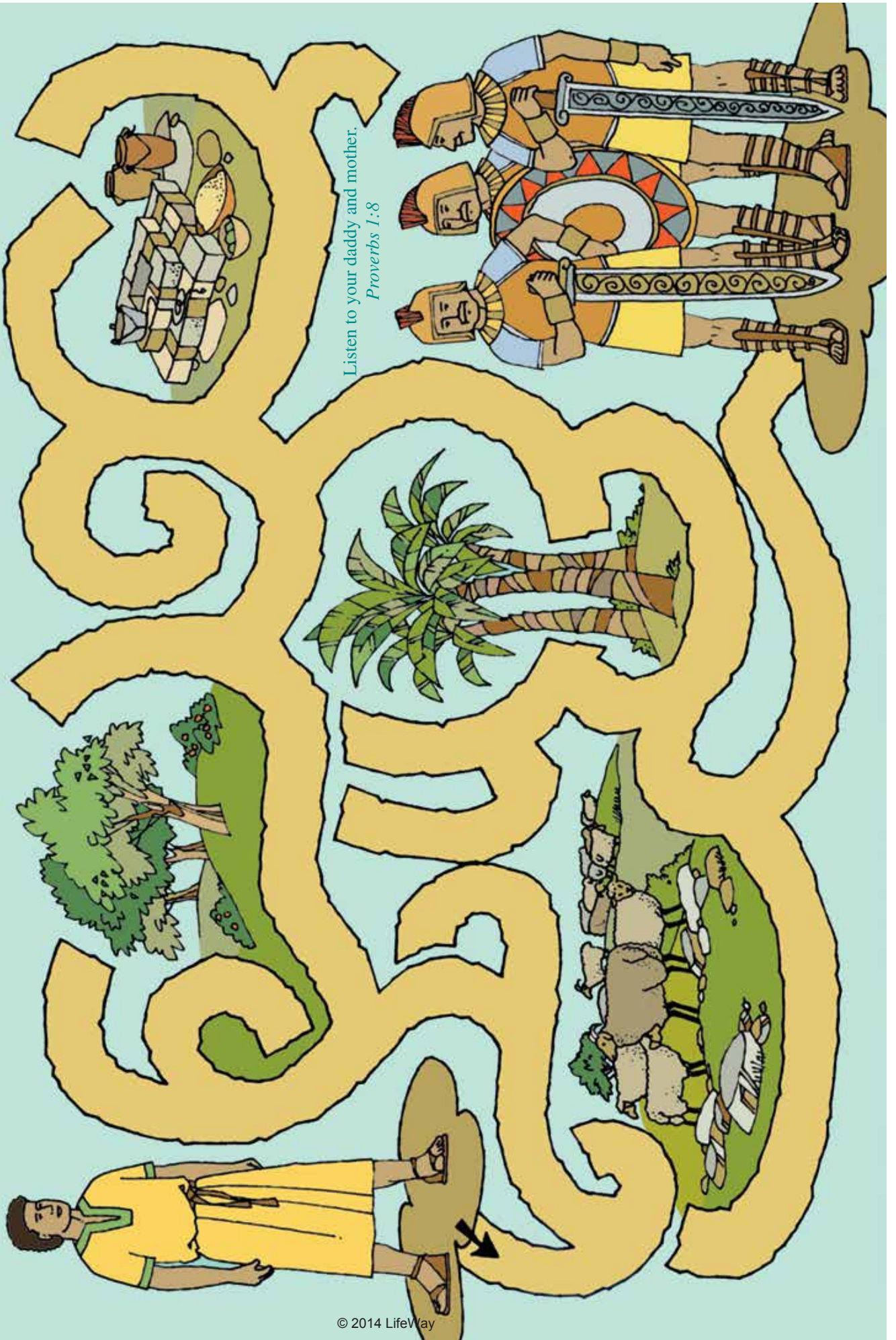
