

The People Built the Tent Church



Bible Phrase: We work together. 1 Corinthians 3:9

Scripture Reference: Exodus 35:1-35; 36:1-6

Bible Story: Moses called all the people together. He told the people that God had a special job for them. God wanted the people to work together to build a tent church.

Moses said that everyone could bring things for building the tent church. The people could bring wood, gold, and sparkly stones. They could bring yarn for making cloth and oil for lighting the lamps. Moses also told the people about special work that needed to be done to build the church.

All the people went home to think about what things they could bring for the tent church. Many people came back bringing gold rings, necklaces, and earrings. Some brought red, purple, and blue yarn to make cloth. Others brought wood, sparkly stones, and oil for the lamps.

The men started working on the church building. Every morning the people kept bringing more things for the tent church. One day the workers told Moses, "We have more things than we need to finish the church." So Moses told the people to stop bringing things. The people were glad they had worked together to give all that was needed.

Parents:

- Mention people your preschooler knows at church and talk about ways they work together. Prompt your child to identify ways to work together with friends in Sunday School. (*cleaning the room, building block structures, and so on*)
- Pray, thanking God that we can work together at church.
