Everywhere Paul went he told people about Jesus. One day Paul went to the Temple. Some people were angry because Paul told about Jesus.



These angry people saw Paul in the Temple. "**Look!**" they shouted. "This is the man we don't like!"

The **angry** people grabbed Paul and dragged him out of the Temple. Some soldiers heard the noise and ran to see what was happening.



The leader of the soldiers thought Paul had done something wrong. He put chains on Paul's hands and feet.

"Who is this man? What did he do?" the leader asked.



Everyone started **shouting** at the same time. The army leader couldn't understand what the people were saying. The army leader told the soldiers to take Paul away from the crowd.


The angry, noisy crowd followed Paul and the soldiers. Paul asked, "May I talk to the people?"
