**Bible Phrase:** Tell others about Jesus. *Mark 16:15*

**Scripture Reference:** Acts 13:1-5; 14:1-3,21-28

**Bible Story:** Paul and Barnabas were teachers at a church in the city of Antioch. They taught the people at church about Jesus.

One day God told the people at church that He had a special job for Paul and Barnabas. God wanted Paul and Barnabas to travel from place to place, telling people about Jesus. Paul and Barnabas would be missionaries.

The people at the church in Antioch prayed for Paul and Barnabas. Then Paul and Barnabas left on their trip. They traveled to many faraway towns. Sometimes they traveled on boats. Sometimes they walked. Everywhere Paul and Barnabas went, they taught people about Jesus. Some people wanted to hear about Jesus. Other people did not. But that did not stop Paul and Barnabas from telling about Jesus.

Then one day, after going to many different towns, Paul and Barnabas sailed back to Antioch on a boat. The people at church were so excited! Everyone came to hear Paul and Barnabas tell about their trip. Paul and Barnabas were glad God had chosen them to be missionaries and tell people about Jesus.
