Bible Phrase: Work together happily. *Ephesians 6:7*

Scripture Reference: *Acts 18:1-4, 18-28*

Bible Story: Paul went many places teaching people about Jesus. While Paul was in the city of Corinth, he met a man named Aquila and his wife, Priscilla. They loved Jesus and wanted to learn more about Him. Aquila and Priscilla invited Paul to live at their house.

During the day, Aquila and Priscilla worked to make tents. Paul knew how to make tents, too. Paul worked together with Aquila and Priscilla to sew tents while he was staying at their house.

Paul, Aquila, and Priscilla became good friends. They liked working together. Aquila and Priscilla traveled to another city with Paul to help him tell people about Jesus. Here Aquila and Priscilla met a man who loved Jesus. His name was Apollos. Aquila and Priscilla invited Apollos to come to their house where they taught him more about Jesus.

Apollos was very glad to learn more about Jesus. Apollos then began traveling to other cities to tell people all he had learned about Jesus.

Parents:

- Ask your child to recall a time when your family worked together. Ask whether she thinks working together made the work more fun and easier.
- Sing (tune "Are You Sleeping?"): "Work together, work together, happily, happily. We can work together; we can work together, happily, happily."
