

Philip Taught from the Bible

Bible Phrase: The Bible teaches about Jesus. *John 5:39*

Scripture Reference: *Acts 8:4-8,26-40*

Bible Story: Philip traveled from town to town, telling people about Jesus. One day an angel (a messenger from God) told Philip to go to a certain road. Philip did what the angel said. He began walking down the road.

As Philip walked, he saw a man riding in a chariot (a wagon with two wheels being pulled by horses). The man sitting in the chariot was from another country. He was reading from a scroll.

Philip ran to the chariot. He heard the man reading aloud. Philip knew the man was reading from the Bible scroll. Philip asked, "Do you understand what you are reading?"

The man said, "No. I need someone to help me."

He invited Philip to sit with him in the chariot. Philip told the man that the words he was reading in the Bible scroll were about Jesus. The man knew about God, but he had not heard about Jesus, God's Son. The man listened carefully as Philip told about Jesus.

Philip told his new friend that Jesus loved him. The man was so happy to know about Jesus. The man loved Jesus, too. The man continued his trip home.
