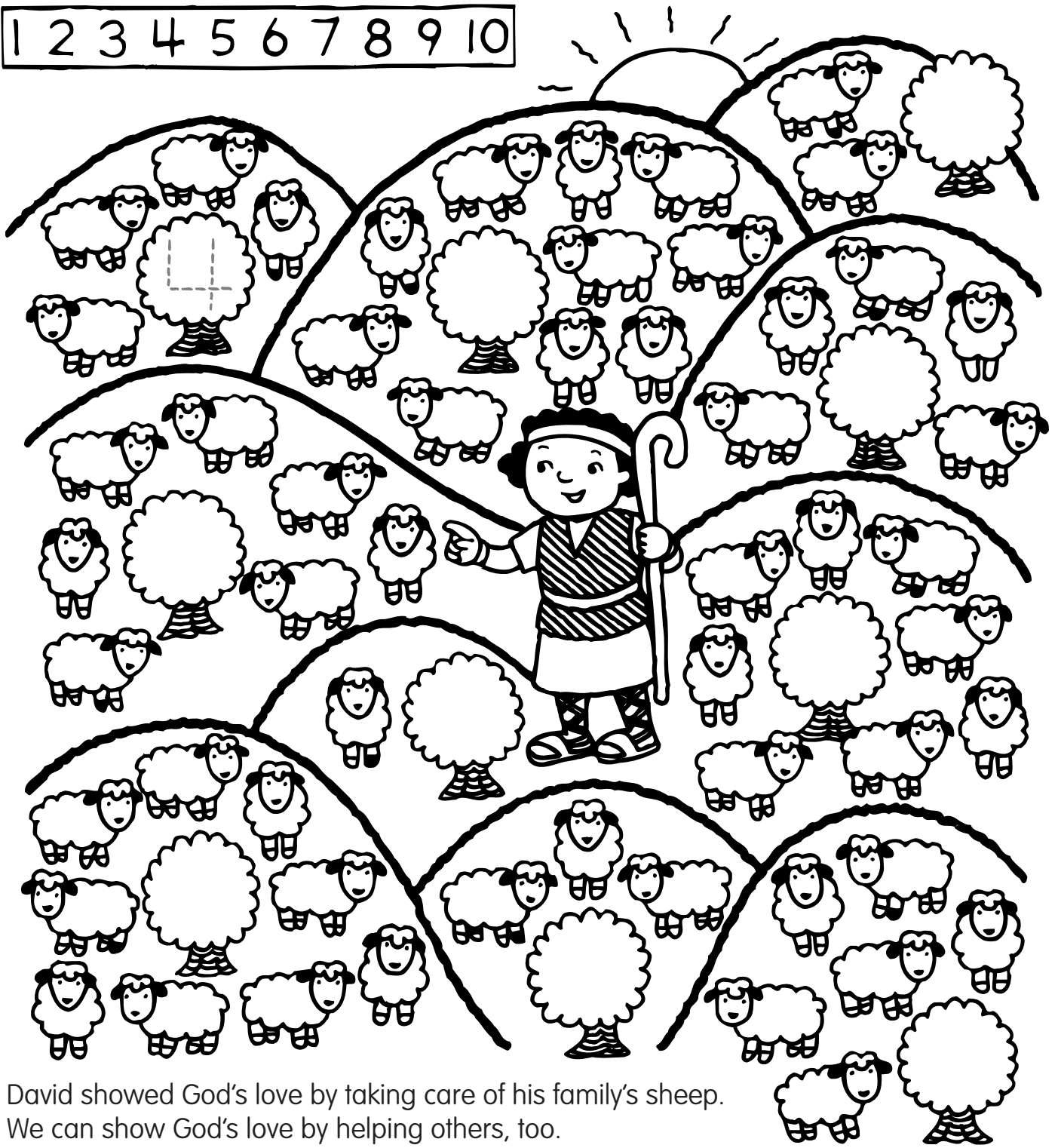
God loved it when David praised Him and thanked Him.
