

David Thanked God

Bible Phrase: Say thank you to God. *Psalms 136:1*

Scripture Reference: *1 Chronicles 15:1-4, 11-12, 14-28; 16:1-43*

Bible Story: King David lived in the city of Jerusalem. He had built many buildings in Jerusalem, but there was no tabernacle (church). King David loved God very much. He wanted the people to have a place where they could come to pray and sing songs to God. So King David built a tabernacle (tent church).

When the tabernacle was finished, King David called the people together. He gave some of the people special jobs to do. David chose some people to move the special tabernacle things into the new tabernacle. Other people were chosen to sing songs and play instruments.

When the day came to move into the new tabernacle, King David asked all the people to come. Some of the people carried the tabernacle things down the road to the new tabernacle. Other people played cymbals, trumpets, and harps. Still others sang songs to God. Everyone walked together to the new tabernacle.

King David was very happy. He sang a song to thank God. His song had words like "Give thanks to God. Sing songs to thank Him. Remember all the wonderful things God has done. Tell everyone about the wonderful things God does. God is great."

Parents:


- As you celebrate Thanksgiving this week, remind your preschooler that God wants us to thank Him for our food, our families, and other things God gives us.




