- Our team has been intentional to make it simple and inexpensive to Celebrate Jesus in fun, age-appropriate ways. You can experience all crafts, games and activities with the “bare minimum” supply list below. However, families who want to take it up a notch with decorations and crafts, may want to gather some or all of the items on the “next level” supply list as well.
- Our content includes downloadable PDFs for those who are able to print at home and want to. These (optional) PDFs include Bible story worksheets and coloring sheets, KidLife participant banners, craft instructions and templates, and daily graphics for celebration displays. With the exception of the worksheets and coloring sheets, all other pieces can be simply drawn/written by preschoolers and their families. The PDFs will be available within the app daily (ex. Day 1 > Create > Craft Instructions PDF), but there is also a Master Preschool KidLife PDF (both color and Black & white versions) available on the Preschool KidLife Start Here tab for those who would like to print everything in advance.

BARE MINIMUM PRESCHOOL KIDLIFE SUPPLY LIST

- Paper (plain white or construction paper)
 - Crayons and/or Markers
 - Scissors (adult OR children)
 - Glue or Glue Sticks
- Tape (to add things to blank wall or door for Celebration Display, LEARN)
 - Paper Plates (non-coated/not foam)
 - Beach Ball (or Small Ball or Balloon) for games (LEARN)
- Scarf (or streamers, small blanket or towel, etc.) for music & movement (LEARN)
 - Blocks (legos, boxes, canned goods, etc.) for building (CREATE)

Next Level Preschool KidLife Supply List (All Of These Items are OPTIONAL!)

- Play dough (purchased or homemade)
- Additional Craft Supplies (dot paints, watercolor paints, stickers, colored pencils, etc.)
 - Cotton balls, Q-tips, straws
 - Bean bags
 - Post-it Notes
 - Poster Board, Wrapping Paper for Celebration Wall (*choose wall or tree)
 - Flower Pot, String or yarn, hole puncher for Celebration Tree (*choose wall or tree)
 - Sidewalk Chalk
 - Musical instruments (egg shakers, tambourine, rhythm sticks, etc.)
 - Flashlight or Glow Stick
- Holiday clothing and decorations (Christmas, Easter, Valentine’s Day, Birthday)
 - Ingredients for meal or snack to share with others as an act of service.
 - Supplies to make cards/posters for friends/neighbors
