**?IS ARMAGEDDON A SINGLE BATTLE, OR COULD IT BE A CAMPAIGN THAT BEGAN THERE? ARE OTHER BATTLES GOING ON?** 

SCENE 1: The gathering of all the armies of the earth to Har-Magedon What is the target, the goal, of this gathering of nations? READ Revelation 16:12-16: the 6th bowl judgment What happens? The angel pours the 6th bowl out on the Euphrates River-Why? What does John see? 3 unclean spirits like frogs: Where did they come from? What are they? What is their purpose? Who are those gathered? Where is Har-Magedon?? 40-60 miles north of Jerusalem HAR=Mount MAGEDON=Mageddo Becomes pronounced "Armageddon" "Valley of Megiddon: term for the plain of Megiddo, the broad portion of the Jezreel Valley in the vicinity of Megiddo." from Holman Illustrated Bible Dictionary This is the site of many Old Testament battles

SCENE 2: <u>The Beast and 10 kings destroy Babylon</u> READ Revelation 16:17-19- 7th bowl judgment "It is done." What happens? The great city is split into 3 parts, cities of great nations fall

"Babylon the great was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of His fierce wrath."

**?**If all the kings and armies are in Har-Magedon, who is going to fight in this battle in Babylon? Revelation 17:16: The Beast and 10 kings

Revelation 17:17: *"For God has put it in their hearts to execute His purpose by having a common purpose, and by giving their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God will be fulfilled."* 

[Remember, in ch.17-18 an angel explains the bowl judgments re/Babylon to John] SCENE 3: Nations against Jerusalem

Babylon is defeated and the Beast and 10 kings come up to join the armies in Har Magedon. Nations are going to be lined up against Israel

"In that day:" What happens to Jerusalem? What happens to the nations that come against Jerusalem? p.114

READ Zechariah 12:2-3-5 p

A siege against Jerusalem

**READ Zechariah 14:1-3** 

All the nations will battle Jerusalem

"THEN":

**READ Zechariah 12:6-9** 

God will...

READ Zechariah 13:1-9

"...a fountain will be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for impurity."

"They will call on My name, And I will say, "They are My people,' and they will say, 'The LORD is my God."

SCENE 4: Armies move toward Edom

A forgotten group of people:

Revelation 12:14: "But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place, where she was nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent."

?Where is that wilderness? Bozrah?

READ Daniel 11:40-41: "At the end time the king of the South will collide with him, and the king of the North will storm against him with chariots, with horsemen and with many ships; and he will enter countries, overflow them and pass through.

He will also enter the Beautiful Land, and many countries will fall; but these will be rescued out of his hand: Edom, Moab and the foremost of the sons of Ammon." See Jeremiah 49:13-17

**READ Revelation 14:16-20** 

Where is the wine press?

-Outside the city

-Blood for 200 miles

Where was/is, Bozrah?

25 miles southeast of the southern stipend of the Dead Sea, at modern Buseirah, or Bezer Bozrah is about 200 miles from Jerusalem

Could it be Petra?

READ Habakkuk 3:3; 12-13: "God comes from Teman, And the Holy One from Mount Paran. His splendor covers the heavens, And the earth is full of His praise." Verses 12-13: "In indignation You marched through the earth; In anger You trampled the nations. You went forth for the salvation of Your people, For the salvation of Your anointed. You struck the head of the house of the evil To lay him open from thigh to neck.

Is this a vision of the future which sees Christ coming from Teman, Mt. Paran, both in Edom? Is the wine press in Edom? p.117

READ Jeremiah 49:13-17: "I have sworn by Myself..." p.117

What happens to Bozrah?

READ Isaiah 63:1-6 "Who is this who..."

Is the wine press 200 miles long?

READ Isaiah 35:10: "And the ransomed of the Lord will return And come with joyful shouting to Zion, With everlasting joy upon their heads. They will find gladness and joy, And sorrow and sighing will flee away."

Is this when the forgotten group of people, the remnant, come out and return to Zion?

## SCENE 5: He stands on the Mount of Olives

READ Joel 3:1-2: "For behold, in those days and at that time, When I restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem, I will gather all the nations And bring them down to the valley of Jehoshaphat. Then I will enter into judgment with them there On behalf of My people and My inheritance, Israel, Whom they have scattered among the nations; And they have divided up My land."
