**Do you need help deciding which study to participate in this semester?  
START HERE!**

1. Pray and ask God for direction and clarity about what He would have you learn?
2. Determine what **TYPE** of study you want to participate in:
  - a. Book of the Bible: study a specific book of Scripture
  - b. Spiritual Discipline Study: prayer, Scripture memory, journaling, etc.
  - c. Topical Study: Scripture that pertains to a specific need/area/season of life
3. Determine your **TIME COMMITMENT** between weekly sessions:
  - a. Minimal – 30 minutes or less per day
  - b. Moderate – 30 – 50 minutes per day
  - c. Advanced – 1 hour + per day
4. Decide the study **FORMAT** that you prefer:
  - a. Print Only
  - b. Print & Video
  - c. Lecture
  - d. Discussion
